



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.

Cairns Speedway Rules, Regulations and General Information

WARNING NOTICE:

Motor Racing is Dangerous & involves risks and dangers to all persons. All persons are reminded that Motor Racing is dangerous and accidents can happen. All care is taken to protect you but you are warned that there is a possibility of an accident causing injury, death or property damage. By purchase of gate ticket, or free entry etc. you hereby acknowledge entry to the complex has a degree of danger and the promoter, club, corporations, organizations, competitors, and any person having any connection with the promoting, organising or conduct of the event shall have no liability to you except where due care and skill has not been exercised.

FOR YOUR SAFETY:

There is to be no glass brought onto the complex. Throwing cans, or any objects whatsoever, on these grounds is an offence. Climbing of fences and buildings is prohibited. Offenders will be removed from the grounds and prosecuted.

INDEMNIFICATION:

North Queensland International Motor Racing Association Inc takes no responsibility for the safety of children and shall not be held responsible to any person or persons, Company or Syndicate for injuries sustained by any person, persons, and/or personnel. Nor will they (the Promoters) accept responsibility for damage of any property whatsoever, regardless to whom it belongs. This also includes loss of properties.

CANCELLATION NOTICE:

In the unfortunate event of a rain-out Cairns Speedway will give "rain checks" but will not refund any money. This entry ticket is your rain check. If this ticket is lost you will not be given a replacement ticket. Rain checks will be honoured at any of the next three race meetings promoted by Cairns Speedway within the current season. Rain checks cannot be used for two-night events or for events run by a third party (eg Other events promoted at Cairns Speedway by southern promoters).

TRADING RIGHTS:

The North Queensland International Motor Racing Association reserves all trading rights at Cairns Motor Speedway, and only authorised competitions & sales are permitted. Persons breaching these conditions may be removed from the premises.

ENTRIES:

The promoters accept competitor entries from the respective clubs, associations and drivers in good faith. Every effort is made to adhere to the entry list, but the promoters cannot accept responsibility for the failure of any entrant to appear. The promoters reserve the right to change, postpone, abandon or cancel the meeting or any part thereof.

ALCOHOL:

The Cairns Speedway is strictly a NO B.Y.O track. Management and security reserve the right upon entrance to the venue to inspect bags, vehicles, eskies or containers for the presence of alcohol. Alcohol is available for purchase at the designated bar areas.

PIT AREA RESTRICTIONS:

Currently, under COVID-19 restrictions, access to the Pit area from the Spectator area is not permitted.
